Automotive Skills Alliance was created in November 2020 under the Pact for Skills, the first flagship action of the European Skills Agenda, firmly anchored in the principles of the European Pillar of Social Rights. The pact aims to mobilise and incentivise private and public stakeholders to invest and take concrete action for the upskilling and reskilling of people.
